## **APPENDIX A: DEFINITIONS**

**Business organization** means a voluntary organization composed of individuals and businesses who have joined together to advance the commercial, financial, industrial and civic interests of a community.

**Charitable organization** is an organization or institution organized and operated to benefit an indefinite number of the public. The service rendered to those eligible for benefits must also confer some benefit upon the public.

**Educational organization** is an organization or institution organized and operated to provide systematic instruction in useful branches of learning by methods common to schools and institutions of learning which compare favorably in their scope and intensity with the course of study presented in tax-supported schools.

**Fraternal organization** is an organization of persons having a common interest, the primary interest of which is to both promote the welfare of its members and to provide assistance to the general public in such a way as to lessen the burdens of government by caring for those who otherwise would be cared for by the government.

**Labor organization** is an organization composed of workers organized with the objective of the betterment of the conditions of those engaged in such pursuit and the development of a higher degree of efficiency in their respective occupations.

**Nonprofit fund-raising organization** is an organization organized for the sole purpose of providing financial assistance to an identified individual or group of individuals suffering extreme financial hardship as the result of illness, disability, accident or disaster.

**Religious organization** is any church, congregation, society or organization founded for the purpose of religious worship.

**Veterans organization** is an organization or association comprised of members of which substantially all are individuals who are veterans or spouses, widows or widowers of veterans, the primary purpose of which is to promote the welfare of its members and to provide assistance to the general public in such a way so to confer a public benefit.

## **APPENDIX B ATTESTATIONS**

**Attestation A:** (For charitable, religious, fraternal, labor, education, veterans and business organizations that have been in existence for at least five years)

**Attestation B:** (For nonprofit fundraising organizations which have been organized for the sole purpose of providing financial assistance to an identified individual or group of individuals suffering extreme financial hardship as the result of illness, disability, accident or disaster.)

"The undersigned attest that the above-named organization is a nonprofit fundraising organization which has been organized for the sole purpose of providing financial assistance to an identified individual or group of individuals suffering extreme financial hardship as the result of illness, disability, accident or disaster. The undersigned do hereby state under penalties of perjury that all statements in the foregoing application are true and correct; that officers, operators, and workers of the games are bona fide members of the sponsoring organization and are all of good moral character, have not been convicted of a felony, and have never been professional gamblers or gambling promoters; that if a license is granted hereunder, the undersigned will be responsible for the conduct of the games in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and Knox County governing the conduct of such games."
